SALAM was founded in 2009 by Rani & Hannah Espanioly along with family and friends in the USA. Rani is an Arab Christian, born and raised in Nazareth, Israel. Hannah is originally from Dallas, Texas. They currently reside in Nazareth—the unofficial Arab capital of the country, where they concentrate their work among the Arab population.

Who Are The Arab Christians?

Arab Christians in the Holy Land are native believers of Jesus and can trace their conversion roots back to the time of Christ. They represent a small minority of the Israeli and Palestinian populations, less than 2% with an even smaller number belonging to the evangelicals. Most of these Arab Christians belong to the Roman Catholic and Greek Orthodox churches.
